AARP MedicareRx plans (PDP)

Plans are insured through UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company or one of its affiliated companies, a Medicare-approved Part D sponsor. Enrollment in the plan depends on the plan's contract renewal with Medicare. You do not need to be an AARP member to enroll. AARP encourages you to consider your needs when selecting products and does not make specific product recommendations for individuals.

OptumRx is an affiliate of UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company. You are not required to use OptumRx home delivery for a 90-day supply of your maintenance medication. \$0 copay is applicable only during the initial coverage phase. This information is not a complete description of benefits. Contact the plan for more information. Limitations, copayments, and restrictions may apply. Premium and/or copayments/coinsurance may change on January 1 of each year.

With Medicare Part D Plans (PDP), you cannot enroll year-round unless you have an Initial Enrollment Period (IEP) or Special Enrollment Period (SEP).

AARP Medicare Supplement Insurance Plans are insured by UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company, Horsham, PA or UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company of New York, Islandia, NY, for New York residents (together called "UnitedHealthcare").
